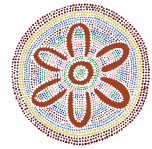

- (b) a letter stamped with the common seal and signed by a delegate of an incorporated Aboriginal and or Torres Strait Islander organisation, such as the Aboriginal Medical Service or an Aboriginal Legal Service.
- (c) Where records are not available, a person's Aboriginal and or Torres Strait Islander identity may be confirmed by a statutory declaration from the individual, declaring that they:
 - (a) are of Aboriginal and or Torres Strait Islander descent;
 - (b) identify as an Aboriginal and or Torres Strait Islander; and
 - (c) are accepted as such by the community in which they live, or previously lived.
